SUPREME COURT RULES REQUIRE THE SUBMISSION OF ALL CIVIL CASES TO AN ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS, UNLESS OTHERWISE EXEMPT.

**Pursuant to the ADR Rules, you are required to take the following action(s):**

1. The parties shall select a neutral and file a "Proof of ADR" form on or by the 210<sup>th</sup> day of the filing of this action. If the parties have not selected a neutral within 210 days, the Clerk of Court shall then appoint a primary and secondary mediator from the current roster on a rotating basis from among those mediators agreeing to accept cases in the county in which the action has been filed.
2. The initial ADR conference must be held within 300 days after the filing of the action.
3. Pre-suit medical malpractice mediations required by S.C. Code §15-79-125 shall be held not later than 120 days after all defendants are served with the "Notice of Intent to File Suit" or as the court directs.
4. Cases are exempt from ADR only upon the following grounds:
  - a. Special proceeding, or actions seeking extraordinary relief such as mandamus, habeas corpus, or prohibition;
  - b. Requests for temporary relief;
  - c. Appeals
  - d. Post Conviction relief matters;
  - e. Contempt of Court proceedings;
  - f. Forfeiture proceedings brought by governmental entities;
  - g. Mortgage foreclosures; and
  - h. Cases that have been previously subjected to an ADR conference, unless otherwise required by Rule 3 or by statute.
5. In cases not subject to ADR, the Chief Judge for Administrative Purposes, upon the motion of the court or of any party, may order a case to mediation.
6. Motion of a party to be exempt from payment of neutral fees due to indigency should be filed with the Court within ten (10) days after the ADR conference has been concluded.



**COMPLAINT**

(Jury Trial Demanded)

Andrew W. Chandler, Esquire, as Special Administrator of the Estate of Doris Duane Colucci, complaining of the acts and/or omissions of the above-named Defendants, alleges and states as follows:

**FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS**

1. Plaintiff Andrew W. Chandler, Esquire ("Plaintiff"), by Order of the Probate Court of Dorchester County filed on July 10, 2017 (C/A No: 2017-ES-18-294), is the duly appointed, qualified, and acting Special Administrator of the Estate of Doris Duane Colucci. At all times pertinent herein, Doris Duane Colucci ("Decedent"), who died on April 14, 2017, was a citizen and resident of Dorchester County, South Carolina.

2. The Defendant, Ivo Francesco Colucci a/k/a Ivo F. Colucci a/k/a Ivo Colucci (“Defendant Colucci”), was Decedent’s husband. At all times pertinent herein, Defendant Colucci was a citizen and resident of Dorchester County, South Carolina.

3. The Defendant, Alice M. Norton (“Defendant Norton”), is Defendant Colucci’s daughter and was appointed to serve as his Guardian by Order of the Dorchester County Probate Court filed on or about April 27, 2017 (C/A No. 2017-GC-18-00004).

4. The Defendant, Christa M. Yantis (“Defendant Yantis”), was appointed to serve as Defendant Colucci’s Conservator by Order of the Dorchester County Probate Court filed on or about April 27, 2017 (C/A No. 2017-GC-18-00004).

5. Defendants Norton and Yantis are named in this lawsuit in their representative capacities only.

6. Defendant Colucci’s Jewelry Factory, Inc. (“Defendant CJF”), is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina with its principal place of business located at 7565 Rivers Avenue, Suite A, North Charleston, South Carolina. Upon information and belief, it owns and operates “Colucci’s Jewelers,” which is located at 7565 Rivers Avenue, Suite A, North Charleston, South Carolina.

7. Defendant Terrivo Enterprises, LLC (“Defendant Terrivo”), is a limited liability company organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina with its principal place of business located in Charleston County, South Carolina.

8. Defendant Terrivo owns the real property located at 7565 Rivers Avenue, Suite A, North Charleston, South Carolina, and, upon information and belief, leases that property to Defendant CJF and/or maintains its principal place of business at that location.

9. Upon information and belief, at all times relevant hereto, Defendant Colucci was an employee, owner, manager, and/or agent of both Defendant CJF and Defendant Terrivo and possessed an ownership interest in Defendant CJF.

10. The tortious acts giving rise to this action took place in Charleston County, South Carolina. As such, venue is proper in this Court.

11. On April 14, 2017, the Decedent and Defendant Colucci were both present at Colucci's Jewelers, with Defendant Colucci acting in his role as an employee, manager, agent, and/or owner of both Defendant CJF and Defendant Terrivo.

12. At approximately 4:20 p.m., Defendant Colucci approached the Decedent, who was present at the store, drew a handgun from his pocket, and shot the Decedent in the head at close range. After shooting the Decedent, Defendant Colucci instructed an employee to call 911, attempted to hide the handgun, checked to see if the Decedent was dead, and then collected the spent casing and put it in his pocket.

13. The Decedent was pronounced dead at the scene by first responders. A copy of the Death Certificate is attached as Exhibit 1.

14. The Charleston County Coroner ruled the death a homicide. A copy of the Coroner's Report is attached as Exhibit 2.

15. An employee and witness to the homicide called 911. Upon his arrival to the scene at approximately 4:20 p.m., Officer Kevin Abbatiello observed Defendant Colucci standing in the doorway of the jewelry store. Officer Abbatiello notes the following in his incident report:

I asked the suspect where the gun was and he stated "inside". I asked the suspect who was shot and he stated "my wife" (Doris Colucci)...During the initial detention the suspect was spontaneously uttering several of the reasons he had shot his wife. During a search incident to the arrest, I located a spent .380 casing

in the suspect's right front pants pocket. I asked the suspect where the casing was from and he stated "I picked it up".

A copy of the Incident Report is attached as Exhibit 3.

16. Footage from the police car in which Defendant Colucci was placed at the scene of the crime following his arrest records Defendant Colucci stating: "It's not what you think, I killed a human, but I had a reason." When reminded that everything inside the police car was being recorded, Defendant Colucci responded that it "doesn't matter anymore, I suffered a whole fucking life."

17. Defendant Colucci was charged with murder. A copy of the Arrest Warrant and Affidavit are attached as Exhibit 4. The Description of the Offense, set forth in the Affidavit, states in part:

That on April 14, 2017 a search warrant was executed at 7565 Rivers Avenue, Suite A to collect evidence of the shooting. As a result of the search warrant video surveillance was located capturing the defendant come into the business and become involved in a verbal altercation with the victim. During the verbal altercation, the defendant was captured on video pulling a firearm out of his pocket, without the victim's knowledge, and shooting the victim in the head. The defendant then hid the firearm utilized on the counter of the business and then went and retrieved the shell casing that was ejected during the shooting and put it in his pocket.

18. The Decedent was 74 years of age at the time of her death.

19. Upon information and belief, Defendant Colucci had regularly exhibited angry outbursts and engaged in arguments with the Decedent at the jewelry store, even threatening violence against her.

20. Despite knowledge of Defendant Colucci's violent tendencies towards the Decedent, he was allowed on the premises of the jewelry store by Defendants CJF and Terrivo and permitted to continue in his role(s) as an employee, manager, agent, and/or owner of those businesses.



21. Upon information and belief, Defendants CJF and Terrivo were aware that Defendant Colucci possessed numerous firearms and regularly carried a concealed weapon while working at the jewelry store and on the premises of Defendants CJF and Terrivo. Despite knowledge of Defendant Colucci's violent tendencies towards the Decedent, Defendants CJF and Terrivo permitted Defendant Colucci to remain, and possess firearms, on their premises.

**FOR A FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION**  
**(Wrongful Death)**

22. Plaintiff repeats, realleges, and incorporates each of the foregoing paragraphs as if fully set forth herein.

23. Plaintiff, as Special Administrator of the Estate of Doris Duane Colucci, brings this action under the South Carolina Wrongful Death Act, S.C. Code Ann. §§ 15-51-10, *et seq.*, on behalf of and for the benefit of the statutory beneficiaries of the Decedent.

24. On April 14, 2017, Defendant Colucci planned and prepared to assault, batter, and kill the Decedent and did thereafter brutally, intentionally, and with malice aforethought shoot the Decedent in the head at point-blank range with a .380 handgun he had placed in his pocket for that purpose. Defendant Colucci acted with a wanton, reckless, willful, and malicious disregard for the rights of the Decedent and with the full knowledge and intent that she would suffer immense pain and fear and, ultimately, die as a result of his actions. Alternatively, Defendant Colucci was careless, negligent, grossly negligent, and heedless in causing the Decedent's death.

25. Defendants CJF and Terrivo, as owners, managers, and employers, owed to the Decedent a duty to exercise reasonable care in the hiring, training, controlling, supervising, and/or retaining of their servant, agent, manager, and/or employee so as to prevent him from

harming the Decedent or from so conducting himself as to create an unreasonable risk of bodily harm to the Decedent.

26. Additionally, Defendants CJF and Terrivo, as owners, managers, and employers, owed to the Decedent a duty of care to maintain their business premises in a reasonably safe condition, including the duty to protect the Decedent from reasonably foreseeable criminal, tortious, and negligent acts of third persons.

27. Defendants CJF and Terrivo breached the duties described above and were careless, negligent, grossly negligent, reckless, willful, wanton, and heedless, in one or more or all of the following particulars, to wit:

- a. Hiring, retaining, and continuing to employ Defendant Colucci and/or allow him to manage the business of Defendants CJF and Terrivo;
- b. Hiring, retaining, and continuing to employ Defendant Colucci and/or allow him to manage the business of Defendants CJF and Terrivo, when Defendant Colucci was known to have a violent disposition or propensity thereby precipitating the assault and resulting murder of the Decedent;
- c. Failing to adequately supervise Defendant Colucci prior to and during the assault and murder of the Decedent;
- d. Failing to maintain proper control over Defendant Colucci;
- e. Failing to maintain their business premises in a reasonably safe condition;
- f. Failing to protect the Decedent from the criminal, tortious, intentional and/or negligent actions and conduct of Defendant Colucci that were reasonably foreseeable under the circumstances;

- g. Permitting Defendant Colucci, whose violent tendencies, outbursts, and prior violent conduct towards the Decedent were known, to be present on their business premises and in possession of a firearm;
- h. Causing and/or allowing the Decedent to be assaulted and murdered; and
- i. Failing to use the degree of care and caution that reasonably prudent persons and entities would have used under the prevailing circumstances.

28. Additionally, under the principles of respondeat superior, the law of agency, and/or the laws of the State of South Carolina, Defendants CJF and Terrivo are vicariously liable for the actions and/or conduct of Defendant Colucci as described herein.

29. At the time of her death, the Decedent was 74 years old and had a life expectancy of 13.64 years pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. § 19-1-150.

30. As a direct, proximate, and foreseeable result of the conduct of the Defendants, as set forth above, and the Decedent's premature death, the Decedent's statutory beneficiaries have suffered damages in the form of outrage; mental shock and suffering; wounded feelings; grief and sorrow; loss of companionship; deprivation of the use and comfort of the Decedent's society; loss of the Decedent's experience, knowledge, and judgment in managing the affairs of herself and her beneficiaries; loss of services; loss of prospective inheritance; pecuniary loss; medical expenses; and funeral and burial expenses; therefore, Plaintiff is entitled to recover actual damages in an amount to be determined by the trier of fact together with the costs and disbursements of this action.

**WHEREFORE**, Plaintiff prays for judgment against Defendants for actual and punitive damages in an amount to be determined by the trier of fact, for Plaintiff's costs and expenses


incurred in the prosecution of this action, and for such other relief as the Court may deem just and proper.

On April 14, 2017 I was dispatched to 7565 Rivers Ave in reference to a shooting.

Upon my arrival, I was met by officers and witnesses in the parking lot. I was directed by Sergeant Ghi to take a witness to my patrol vehicle and make sure she was okay or needed anything. I complied and placed the witness in the back of my patrol vehicle. North Charleston Police Detectives arrived on scene and began asking the witness questions on the shooting who stated that the suspect shot the victim. I was then directed by detectives to take the witness to the detective bay at North Charleston City Hall which I complied.

This incident was captured on my body worn camera and in car camera.

I, Sgt. H. M. Thomas, responded to the Incident location, in reference to a shooting. Upon my arrival, I observed Ptl. Abbatiello patting down a Grey haired Older male. I approached them and asked Officer Abbatiello what we had. He responded "Husband shot his wife". I asked him if this was the suspect and he confirmed that it was. I then asked where the gun was located and he stated that the suspect said it was inside the business laying next to a grey jacket or sweater. I then observed Ptl. Besancon, who had just exited the business, and asked him if the victim was deceased, in which he stated yes. I then proceeded inside the Jewelry store, where Fire Medic, Captain Versetti, and two other officers were located. I then observed an elderly white female laying behind the counter on her back with a large amount of blood and brain matter present. It was obvious that the victim was deceased. I then exited the business and made sure that Ptl. Besancon and Ptl. Reid held their witnesses for the detectives. After several minutes, Detectives, Crime scene, and members of the command staff arrived. I cleared the scene.

The affiant states there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth, and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:


That on April 14, 2017 while at 7565 Rivers Avenue, Suite A, Colucci's, which is located in the City of North Charleston, County and State aforesaid the above named defendant, **Ivo Francesco Colucci** did violate section 16-3-10 of the South Carolina State Code of Laws of 1976 as amended; **Murder** in that he did willfully, unlawfully and feloniously while armed with a firearm shoot and mortally wound his wife, Doris Duane Colucci.

That on April 14, 2017 Officers of the North Charleston Police Department responded to a shooting at the aforementioned business. Upon arrival the victim, Doris Duana Colucci, was discovered deceased from an apparent gunshot wound.


That on April 14, 2017 a search warrant was executed at 7565 Rivers Avenue, Suite A to collect evidence of the shooting. As a result of the search warrant video surveillance was located capturing the defendant come into the business and become involved in a verbal altercation with the victim. During the verbal altercation the defendant was captured on video pulling a firearm out of his pocket, without the victim's knowledge, and shooting the victim in the head. The defendant then hid the firearm utilized on the counter of the business and then went and retrieved the shell casing that was ejected during the shooting and put it in his pocket.
