Subject: SC-01 POLL: MACE OPENS COMMANDING LEAD PRIMARY RACE

In a recent poll conducted by Victory Opinion Research for the Mace campaign, the primary race is starting to show signs of ending before it ever really begins.

Congresswoman Mace, having won both her primary and general election in 2022 by double digits, started off with a strong 17 point lead in her primary election in our February survey.

That lead has now grown to 26 points, with Mace up 48-22 over Catherine Templeton, the puppet of the DC establishment Swamp.

Mace has nearly double the favorables as Templeton, and has now earned the endorsement of President Donald Trump, who has a 70-28 approval rating in the primary.

Trump's endorsement came before this recent poll, but data shows a percentage of the voting electorate still don't know about it, which means when the Trump endorsement of Mace penetrates fully through the electorate, her primary election numbers will only go up.

Congresswoman Mace has virtually identical numbers across the district, and among male and female voters, making her one of the few GOP elected officials without a gender gap.

She does the best among the most conservative voters with an astonishing +45 net approval rating. Those are of course the most likely voters to show up in what is expected to be a low turnout primary election.

There is only one conclusion that can be reached here: Catherine Templeton should drop out of the race, and join President Trump in working to re-elect Nancy Mace for Congress.

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
