I pulled Ms. Word to the side away from everyone else so she could advise me what all happened.

Ms. Word advised me that she and _____ had went to the Laurens City Square for the sip and stroll to meet with a few of her friends. Ms. Word then advised me that she could not purchase the tickets that were needed to sip the wine so she and _____ sat with a few friends to eat dinner and listen to the music. Ms. Word advised she had one beer with her dinner and did not drink anymore because she knew she had to drive home as well as having _____ with her.

Ms. Word advised that while she was out with her friends that _____ was constantly texting and calling her asking when she would be home. Ms. Word showed Ofc. Tomlinson the text messages (which will be attached to the report). One specific text message to Ms. Word from _____ was "If you are fucking drinking and get in the car to bring _____ home, I will Fucking kill you". Ms. Word advised officers she stayed

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out a while longer due to her not wanting to go home because of [REDACTED] being in that state of mind.

Once Ms. Word arrives home with [REDACTED] at the listed location, she leaves the car running due to [REDACTED] being asleep, while she goes inside of the home to gather a few belongings so she could stay at her parents house.

Once Ms. Word comes back outside to the vehicle, she gets in and starts to back out of the driveway, [REDACTED] goes to the rear passenger side door and opens it, preventing Ms. Word from leaving the driveway. [REDACTED] then pushes on the rear passenger side door forward, after Ms. Word attempts to back out of the driveway again.

Ms. Word then gets out of the vehicle, and she and [REDACTED] start to verbally argue with one another. [REDACTED] then goes into the back seat to get [REDACTED] out of the vehicle. [REDACTED] continues to hug [REDACTED] while Ms. Word goes back into the home to gather [REDACTED] rain machine. [REDACTED] then puts [REDACTED] back into the car seat, and then starts to talk to Ms. Word.

While the two are talking [REDACTED] parents pull up into the drive way, Ms. Word then goes to her drivers side door to leave and [REDACTED] then stands in the way of the passenger rear door preventing Ms. Word from leaving.

Once [REDACTED] parents approached Ms. Words vehicle, they start to verbally argue again, Mr. Words father then walks to the drivers side door where Ms. Word was and pushed her door against her hitting her. Ms. Word continues to argue with [REDACTED] and his father and then reaches to grab [REDACTED] in the heated argument. [REDACTED] father then grabs [REDACTED] and separates him from Ms. Word.

Ms. Word then gets into her vehicle and waits for her father to come to the house.

In reference to everything that Ms. Word advised officers, myself, LT Richards and Chief Grounsell were able to confirm everything with the security footage that is on the side of the home facing where the incident happened. (BWC was worn when Ms. Word allowed officers to view the security footage).

While we were watching security footage, [REDACTED] did complete and voluntary statement form for his side of things that happened.

DETAILED STATEMENT OF INVESTIGATION: I, SRO H.R. Tomlinson, responded to [REDACTED] in the city limits of Laurens for report of possible domestic occurring in the yard of the residence. While in route dispatch called me by phone to alert me this was the residence of [REDACTED]. I arrived at the residence after Sgt. Lowe with the Laurens County Sheriff's Office who met me and stated situation did involve [REDACTED]. I observed [REDACTED] leaned against a vehicle in the yard with an older male identified as his father. I asked [REDACTED] what was going on who stated he had been in an argument with [REDACTED] Alexandria Word and [REDACTED] about not coming home but all was good now. I then went to speak with Word who I located seated in a vehicle. I observed Word to be visibly upset, crying, speaking loudly and excitedly. Word stated that she had gone to an event on the square with friends and while there started receiving text messages from [REDACTED] about her coming home.

I was shown text she sent to [REDACTED] stating:

"Right now is not the time to have this conversation. We need to discuss this later. I was trying to have a night with my friends to decompress and you're making it difficult. [REDACTED] is safe. I am safe. I will come home later."

[REDACTED] replied:

"I don't need to discuss shit with someone who thinks their friends are more important. And if you think you're going to have a conversation with me later, you've (his grammar error) sadly mistaken."

"When the fuck are you coming home alexi?"

"If you are fucking drinking and get in the car to bring [REDACTED] home, I will fucking kill you"

"This shit was over at 9 o'clock and you still out. Wtf are you doing"

Word stated when she got home she was going to get items then leave for her parents home for the night. She stated that an argument began and she got in her vehicle to leave when [REDACTED] blocked her from leaving. She stated [REDACTED] called his parents who arrived and made situation escalate. She stated she was afraid for her safety and called her father to come to her. I asked if she would provide a written statement which she did.

[REDACTED] also provided a written voluntary statement.

I notified Lt Richards who responded as did M. Davis and Chief Grounsell.

Captain Duckett, Sgt. Wicker, Sgt. Lowe and Lt. Byrd from the Sheriff's Office also responded.
