NARRATIVE	<p>On 11/05/15 the victim reported that the offender was in violation of their family court (child visitation) order. The victim said that he went to the offender's residence to pick up the children for his scheduled afternoon visitation. The victim said that when he got there (an hour before he was to return the children back home) the offender refused to allow the victim to take the children. The victim said that the offender's refusal put her in violation of their Family Court order.</p> <p>The offender said the only reason that she did not let the victim take the children is because it was not safe for the victim to do so. The offender said that she would never keep the children away from the victim. The offender said she told the victim that he needed to have someone drive him over to get the children because the victim did not need to be driving. The victim's right foot and left arm was injured to the point that the victim was walking with crutches and both his right leg/foot and left arm was wrapped with a soft cast. The victim could only use his right hand/arm and left foot (for the gas and brake peddle) to drive; the offender said that simply was not safe for their children and that she was only doing what was safe for the children.</p>

When asked if he felt it was safe for him to be driving the children around with his injuries the victim said "absolutely." The victim said that he drives with his left foot all of the time. None the less the offender felt that it was simply too unsafe for the victim to be driving the children around. The victim argued that the offender was in violation with the court order. By the time reporting officer listened to both arguments the allowed time for the victim to have the children had nearly passed; the children were not allowed to go with the victim.
