



1. On October 1, 2024, Kendall Faith Mims was arrested for Accessory After the Fact of Murder, Obstruction of Justice, and Misprision of a Felony.
2. Bond was denied on all charges by the Magistrate.
3. Bond was denied again by Judge Sprouse on December 10, 2024. He cited the lack of discovery and evidence being the reason, and he allowed for bond to be re-visited in 90 days.
4. Ms. Mims asks for a reasonable bond and GPS monitoring.
5. She has no criminal record, no passport, and no financial means to leave South Carolina. She has strong family ties to this area.
6. Prior to her arrest, Ms. Mims resided on her grandfather's property with her infant child. Since her arrest, her eighty-one-year-old grandfather has been the primary caregiver for her baby.
7. Her grandfather greatly aided Pendleton Law Enforcement during the investigation.
