NARRATIVE

ON SEPTEMBER 6, 2021 AT APPROXIMATELY 0854 HOURS, I, PFC LOIZZI, RESPONDED TO 1145 YORKSHIRE PKWY, WHICH IS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF MYRTLE BEACH, IN REFERENCE TO A DROWNING.

WHEN I ARRIVED ON SCENE I OBSERVED A WHEELCHAIR IN THE POOL AND BEGAN SPEAKING TO WITNESSES AND FAMILY MEMBERS. THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED BY MEDICS TO THE HOSPITAL AND SGT GIBSON WAS NOTIFIED.

THERE IS NOTHING FURTHER AT THIS TIME.

WHEN I ARRIVED ON SCENE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT WAS DOING CPR ON THE VICTIM AND GETTING HIM READY FOR TRANSPORT. INVOLVED OTHER 1 HAD APPROACHED ME SAYING THE VICTIM HAD A [REDACTED] THE VICTIM HAD DONE DURING A TRIP TO VIRGINIA. I ASKED INVOLVED OTHER 1 IF SHE COULD SUPPLY US WITH THE PAPERWORK. WHEN INVOLVED OTHER 1 CAME BACK, SHE DID NOT HAVE A FORM FILLED OUT FOR A [REDACTED].

INVOLVED OTHER 2 STATED THAT HE WAS IN THE AREA OF THE POOL WHEN HE SAW THE VICTIM OUT FOR HIS NORMAL TOUR AROUND THE NEIGHBORHOOD. INVOLVED OTHER 2 SAYS THE VICTIM APPROACHED HIM ABOUT OPENING UP THE DOOR TO THE POOL FOR HIM TO ENTER BECAUSE HE WAS GOING TO BE PLAYING CHESS WITH SOMEONE. INVOLVED OTHER 2 USED HIS KEY CARD TO OPEN THE DOOR TO LET THE VICTIM IN. INVOLVED OTHER 2 DID NOT FOLLOW.

DET SOUOUD WAS NOTIFIED AND RESPONDED TO THE SCENE. SGT GIBSON NOTIFIED CRIME SCENE TO RESPOND AS WELL. DURING THAT TIME, BEFORE THEY ARRIVED, SOMEONE WITH THE HOA WHO HAS ACCESS TO THE CAMERAS ARRIVED ON SCENE AND WE WERE ABLE TO VIEW THEM.

THE CAMERA SHOWS THE VICTIM ENTERING INTO THE POOL AREA AND GOING OVER TO THE AREA WHERE THE CHESS SETS ARE. THE VICTIM IS THEN SEEN WITH HIS DOG LEAVING THAT AREA AND DRIVING AROUND THE POOL. THE VICTIM THEN STOPS AT A CURVE IN THE POOL AND THEN SUDDENLY MOVES QUICKLY FORWARD AND GOES INTO THE WATER. THE VICTIM IS SEEN LIFTING HIS HEAD UP A FEW TIMES BEFORE THE CAMERA CUTS TO A DIFFERENT TIME. THE CAMERA THEN SHOWS THE FIRE DEPARTMENT RESPONDING. THE VICTIM IS ON CAMERA GOING INTO THE POOL AT 7:56 THEN A MEMBER OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT JUMPS IN AT 8:56. THERE WAS NO ONE ELSE IN THE POOL AREA AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT. PFC SCHAEFER ARRIVED ON SCENE TO MAKE A COPY OF THE CAMERA FOOTAGE.

DET SOUOUD REQUESTED THE WHEELCHAIR BE PLACED INTO PROPERTY AND EVIDENCE FOR THE FAMILY TO COME RETRIEVE IT. THE WHEELCHAIR WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND PLACED INTO PROPERTY AND EVIDENCE ALONG WITH A BLACK BACKPACK THAT WAS WITH THE WHEELCHAIR.

BATTALION CHIEF MITCHELL STATED HE WOULD MAKE THE CALL TO DHEC IN REFERENCE TO THIS INCIDENT.

THERE IS NOTHING FURTHER AT THIS TIME.

ON SEPTEMBER, 06, 2021 I RESPONDED TO THE COMMUNITY POOL AT 1145 YORKSHIRE PKWY IN THE CITY OF MYRTLE BEACH FOR THE REPORT OF A MALE SUBJECT DROWNING IN THE POOL.

UPON ARRIVAL MBFD PERSONNEL HAD ALREADY EXTRACATED THE MALE VICTIM FROM THE POOL AND WERE PERFORMING CPR.

WHILE MBFD WAS TENDING TO THE VICTIM I BEGAN TO SEPERATE WITNESSES FROM ON LOOKERS AND EVACUATE THE PEOPLE WHO WERE NOT PERTINENT TO THE SCENE.

I NOTIFIED MBPD SGT GIBSON OF THE SITUATION AND HE NOTIFIED DET SOUQUD AND CRIME SCENE INVESTIGATOR RAA-SCHAFFER WHO ARRIVED ON SCENE TO PERFORM THEIR INVESTIGATIONS.

I WAS ABLE TO IDENTIFY FOUR WITNESSES WHO ALL REPORTED THAT THEY ARRIVED AT APPROXIMATELY 0830-0840 THE MORNING OF THE DATE ABOVE AND NOTICED AN OBJECT IN THE POOL WHICH THEY THOUGHT WAS A FLOAT OR TOY LEFT IN THE POOL BY ONE OF THE KIDS OR COMMUNITY MEMEBERS THE NIGHT BEFORE. THEY REPORTED THAT WHEN THEY LOOKED CLOSER THEY REALIZED IT WAS ONE OF THEIR COMMUNITY MEMBERS THEY KNEW TO BE THE (VICTIM) SKINNER, CHISTOPHER. ONE OF THE WITNESSES, NORRIS NANCY IMMEDIATELY CALLED 911.

MBFD AMBULANCE ARRIVED AND BEGAN TO GET THE VICTIM LOADED FOR TRANSPORT TO GSR. AT THAT TIME THE VICTIM`S WIFE ARRIVED ON SCENE AND POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED THE VICTIM`S IDENTITY. THE VICTIM WAS THEN LOADED AND TRANSPORTED.

MBPD OFFICER LOIZZI ARRIVED ON SCENE AND BEGAN INTERVIEWING THE VICTIM`S WIFE (IO) AS WELL AS OTHER PEOPLE ON SCENE TO HELP GET MORE INFORMATION.

DUE TO HER BACKGROUND/TRAINING FOR DROWNING INCIDENTS, OFFICER LOIZZI TOOK OVER AS THE PRIMARY UNIT IN THIS CASE.

Received a phone call From Sgt Gibson in reference to a 10-7 Drowning. Arrived on scene and was advised by the fire dept that the victim has been transported to the hospital. The Victim was wheelchair bound and has been paralyzed for 21 years and only has use of his neck muscles and biceps. I spoke with the wife of the victim who advised that his daily routine consists of going to the pool every morning and that nothing was unusual this morning and that he wasn't suicidal. I reviewed video surveillance which is motion activated. The Victim, makes entry into the pool with his dog and then at 0756 hours, his wheelchair is seen moving towards the water and then the victim falls in along with his wheelchair which he is strapped to and is seen attempting to pull his head up. the victim is under water for over 40 minutes before someone locates him and calls it in. I responded to GSR where I was advised that the victim was on life support but that he had no brain function.

I spoke to Eric Tatro [REDACTED].



Eric who is the neighbor of the victim stated that the victim called out to him and asked him if he had the key card to get into the pool and he let him in. he advised that the victim told him that he was meeting someone at the pool to play chess with. he advised that he was unaware who this person was and to his knowledge there was no one at the pool.

I reviewed video footage and observed the victim go into the pool at around 0752 hours and make his way towards the back where the chess board is. the camera cuts off due to motion activation. at 7:56, the victim is seen making his way towards the pool area round about where he is observed going into the pool with his wheelchair which he was strapped to. The victim is observed attempting to pull his head up but is unable to do so. the victim is under water for 40 minutes before paramedics arrive on scene to render aid.

The victim was transported to GSR and life saving measures were preformed. the victim was on a ventilator but had no brain activity.

The wife of the victim advised that he had [REDACTED] paperwork.

the victim's belongings were transported to the police department and dropped as evidence and eligible to be released to the family. [09/07/2021 08:04, ASOUOUD, 303, MBPD]

The victim's belongings were released to a Robert Raff who is the victim's friend, it was released per the victim's wife. [09/07/2021 13:54, ASOUOUD, 303, MBPD]
