TO: THE SHERIFF OF GREENVILLE COUNTY, AND ANY DULY AUTHORIZED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER:

WHEREAS, by Order dated March 26, 2025, Defendant Jasper Marshall Dye III was ordered to appear before me in supplemental proceedings on May 15, 2025, and it appears by reference to the Affidavit of Service that the Defendant was personally served on March 28, 2025 with the Order requiring the Defendant's attendance at the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Defendant Jasper Marshall Dye III failed to appear as required by the Order dated May 15, 2025; and

WHEREAS, by Order dated May 16, 2025, Defendant Jasper Marshall Dye III was ordered to appear before me in supplemental proceedings on July 2, 2025 and to show cause why he should not be held in contempt of this Court for failure to comply with the aforesaid Order dated May 15, 2025, and it appears by reference to the Affidavit(s) of Service that the Defendant was personally served on May 29, 2025 with the Order requiring the Defendant's attendance at the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Defendant failed to appear as required by the Order of May 19, 2025 or furnish the undersigned any reason for the failure to appear. Thereafter, and as noted by way of letter by Plaintiff's attorney filed July 22, 2025, Dye was advised that unless he contacted Plaintiff's attorney within 10 days, an Order of Arrest would be sought. There was no response to said letter.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Sheriff of Greenville County and any duly authorized law enforcement officer is hereby required forthwith to arrest the above-named Jasper Marshall Dye III, and place him in the Greenville County Jail or otherwise hold him in custody, there to hold said person until (s)he is brought at the first reasonably available opportunity before this Court. Upon the arrest, the arresting agency shall promptly notify the Court (864-467-8556) of the arrest. A hearing shall be held within 72 hours of said notification.

The Clerk of Court is directed to issue a Bench Warrant pursuant to this Order.
