

FULL STATEMENT FROM APRIL MONROE

I unequivocally deny the allegations in filing a false police report to the best of my ability. My son and I have been fully cooperative, communicative, and honest with Mount Pleasant Police Department throughout this investigation and to Deputy Chief Kelly LaPlante of 1st circuit solicitors' office.

I am hopeful the truth behind these misguided assertions will be revealed, and authentic facts will be brought to light. This misleading narrative perpetuated will be formally addressed. **Enough is enough..I assure you I will not be deterred by any tactics employed by the Templeton Family during this legal process.**

My son and I will continue to cooperate and provide further documentation needed. I feel confident the truth will prevail itself and hope our justice system will consider all documentation presented.

As for Mr. Condon's remarks about an ongoing civil matter against another family including as to who he cites as being "Mr. And Mrs. Wagner".. I want it to be clear my family has not received any monetary compensation or restitution from anyone. The criminal case Mr. Condon is referring to was handled by the 9th Circuit Solicitors office and I will leave it at that. Much like the Templeton case, I have nothing to hide and encourage those interested to look into to do so-that is if information is not already "sealed" and or hidden for the public to view.

I'm done being silenced. It's time the truth be revealed, authentic facts be disclosed surrounding this case and justice be served accordingly.

My purpose is to advocate for my son, remain vocal and to avoid the truth from being misconstrued. Throughout this case, I have been honest and there is sound evidence supporting my claims.
