First Observations:

On October 8th, 2025, at approximately 8:40 pm, I Ofc. Dense was conducting traffic enforcement in the City of Folly Beach. I was dispatched to 2nd St, at East Ashley Ave, in regard to a two vehicle, motor vehicle collision. I arrived on scene shortly after and met with the two gentlemen involved. I spoke with the occupants of the white Jeep first. I identified the driver He stated he was driving the vehicle and had stopped at a stop sign heading northbound on 2nd St East, at the intersection of 2nd St and East Ashley Ave. A vehicle was driving eastbound on East Ashley Ave and had stopped at the crosswalk, in the intersection. Following that vehicle continuing East, he pulled out into the intersection before being struck on the rear, driver side door of his vehicle, by a truck traveling eastbound on East Ashley Ave. He stated he was not injured.

I then met with the other driver, identified by SC DL as Ronald Dean Rallis Jr. I asked the driver where he was coming from and he asked his daughter who was seated in the vehicle with him. She said from dinner. I then asked again where he was coming from and he stated from soccer and dinner. I asked him what happened. He told me, nothing, absolutely nothing, it was just a wreck. I asked him what direction he was coming from and he told me, I was going straight. I noticed as we spoke the driver was periodically displaying slurred speech, as well as, I could detect an odor of alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath as I stood next to him and engaged in conversation. I requested his drivers license and vehicle documents. He told me of course and began looking for them. I asked him where dinner was and he told me Mex 1. I again requested his vehicle information and he stated yes. The subject appeared very disoriented. When I asked again for his documents and told him I had instructed him several times to retrieve them for me, he replied, my friend, that's the first time you have asked. His confusion and lack of awareness were consistent with signs of impairment.

Once other units had arrived on scene, I requested that he step out of his vehicle. After moving away from his child, I asked him how much he had to drink. He replied, one drink. I observed, once we were in better lighting, his eyes were watery and bloodshot. I requested he participate in SFST's. He stated, "I am absolutely not doing that. Zero chance of me doing that". When I advised the subject that he was under arrest (9:05pm), he began to resist by pulling his arms forward and yelling, "Wait wait". The subject continued to tense his arms. He was guided into a wall, at which point he was placed into handcuffs. He then was advised of his Miranda Rights.

He was then transported to Folly Beach DPS HQ and seated in the datamaster DMT, breath alcohol testing

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room. Implied consent was read at 2140 hrs. A twenty minute observation period was not completed. This was due to Rallis Jr refusing to provide a breath sample. A South Carolina DMV notice of suspension was completed and served. His vehicle was legally parked and was not towed. His daughter was released, with his consent to He was transported to 945 Folly Rd, where he was medically cleared. He was then transported to Charleston County ADC and transferred custody to CCSO.
