ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME REPORTING DEPUTY RESPONDED TO THE ABOVE ADDRESS FOR A DOG ATTACK WHAT WAS FIRST GIVEN OUT TO THE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT. THE VICTIM IS A US POST OFFICE EMPLOYEE WHO WAS DELIVERING A PACKAGE TO THE DOOR WHEN THE BLACK AND WHITE PIT BULL STARTED ATTACKING THE VICTIM ATTEMPTED TO GET INTO MAIL VEHICLE WHEN THE DOG FOLLOWED INTO THE VEHICLE AND CONTINUED TO ATTACK.

NEWBERRY POLICE ARRIVED ON SCENE SPRAYING THE DOG AND RENDERING AID TO THE VICTIM AFTER CALLING FOR EMS. THE VICTIM WAS TAKEN BY AMBULANCE TO AN LZ IN LITTLE MOUNTAIN AND FLOWN TO GREENVILLE.

ANIMAL CONTROL WAS ALREADY ON SCENE WHEN DEPUTIES ARRIVED AND WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF NEWBERRY POLICE DEPUTIES WERE ABLE TO CATCH THE DOG. THE OWNER (SUBJECT 1) OF THE DOG ARRIVED ON SCENE AND AGREED TO BRING THE DOG TO THE ANIMAL SHELTER TO BE QUARANTINED.

DETAILED STATEMENT OF INVESTIGATION: REPORTING DEPUTY REACHED OUT TO ANIMAL CONTROL ON THE STATUS OF THE DOG INVOLVED IN THE INITIAL CASE. ANIMAL CONTROL ADVISED THAT THE DOG WAS IN QUARANTINE FOR 10 DAYS AT THE SHELTER. REPORTING DEPUTY SPOKE WITH THEM IN REFERENCE TO A POSSIBLE CRIMINAL CHARGES.

THE SHELTER EMPLOYEES ADVISED THE DOG WAS ON ITS PROPERTY AT THE TIME OF INCIDENT. THE DOG ALSO HAD AN ELECTRONIC FENCE COLLAR ON TO PREVENT IT FROM LEAVING THE PROPERTY.

REPORTING DEPUTY ATTEMPTED CONTACT WITH THE VICTIM, THE VICTIMS VOICE MAIL PICKED UP. REPORTING DEPUTY LEFT A MESSAGE FOR A RETURN CALL.
