Good morning! I trust all is well at the U.S. Attorney's Office.

I'm reaching out to follow up on a few items — both discussed and not discussed — during last week's press conference following the guilty pleas of **Chuck Wright, Amos Durham** and **Lawson "L.B." Watson**:

- 1.) Can the USAO clarify when the federal investigation began?
- 2.) 10th Circuit Solicitor **Micah Black** stated he "believed" one of the offenses Wright pleaded to in federal court involved the theft of approximately **\$1,188** from what appears to be a separate sheriff's office fund to which Wright had access. This discrepancy was logged in a Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office incident report in April. SLED confirmed it was "aware of this information" in October. Can the USAO confirm whether this matter was included in the federal case?
- 3.) Regarding the withdrawals made by Wright and Durham from the sheriff's office benevolence fund: Can the USAO confirm the denominations of the banknotes involved (e.x, \$20s, \$50s, \$100s)?
